



**I'm so Disappointed in You!**

**Key Take Away: God will never say, “I am disappointed in you.”**

- **Disappointment means “unmet expectations” or “to let down.”**

**The Lie: “God is disappointed in you!”**

**The Truth: God has never been and never will be disappointed with you.**

- **Truth # 1: God knows everything (Isaiah 40:13-14; Job 38:2; Isaiah 55:8-9).**
- **Truth # 2: God created you (Psalm 139:13-16, 23-24).**

God knows **everything** about you.

God knows every one of our potential **thoughts** and **actions**.

Instead of **fleeing** God’s scrutiny, welcome it.

God knows **more** about you than you do.

- **Truth # 3: God sent Jesus to die for your sins even before you committed any (Romans 5:8).**

We need to **accept** the biblical fact that God knows everything about us and chose to love us anyway.

You will never hear Jesus say, “I’m disappointed in you.” Praise the Lord for this marvelous truth..
