Four Principles from Abraham

- 1. Waiting is not standing still; but it is moving ahead by faith.**
- 2. Waiting is not putting our minds in neutral; it is hearing by faith.**
- 3. Waiting is not looking around; it is looking ahead by faith.**
- 4. Waiting is not clinging to the promise; it is clinging to the provider of faith.**

Biblical Truths

- 1. The Most committed Christians are sometimes exposed to the most trying times.**
- 2. When God is in charge, plans should not degenerate into panic.**
- 3. When God is in control, trust should not dissolve into blame.**
- 4. Most often, the answers from God do not arrive until the darkest moments are experienced.**
- 5. When your voice is silent and God works in you, there is little difficulty in recognizing His power.**
- 6. When your strength is broken and God works through you, there is no question who receives the credit.**
- 7. While God's solution may be temporary, the lessons learned can last a lifetime.**
